## ORDINANCE NO. 1992- 4

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4-A OF ORDINANCE NO. 1986-1, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLIAMSFIELD

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Williamsfield, Illinois, Section 4-A of Ordinance No. 1986-1 shall be amended as follows:

## SECTION 4: PRESENCE OF PERSONS OF NONAGE UPON LICENSED PREMISES:

- A. No person under the age of twenty-one shall be permitted on a premise licensed pursuant to this Ordinance between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. except as follows:
- 1. Any person shall be permitted on a portion of a premise licensed pursuant to this Ordinance if that portion has a separate entrance; has, as its primary source of income, the sale of food; and such portion of a premise is not used for consumption of alcoholic beverages except as a part of the normal service of food. Such an area shall be called a "dining room".
- 2. Any person working in a dining room licensed pursuant to this Ordinance shall be at least twenty-one years old, except for food preparation and service persons working in food preparation and service areas adjacent to the dining room. Such food preparation and service areas shall be separated from the area devoted primarily to the consumption of alcoholic beverages. No person under the age of twenty-one shall be allowed in the dining area after the hour of 10:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday nor after 11:00 p.m. Friday and Saturday.
- 3. Any conviction for underage consumption of alcoholic beverages in the dining room of any premise licensed pursuant to this Ordinance shall be cause to eliminate the eligibility of that dining room under Section 4, Paragraph 1.
